### 1. Minutes of Academic Council Meeting 21st March 2023

**AGREED:** The minutes of the Academic Council Meeting of 21<sup>st</sup> March 2023 were approved.

### 2. Matters Arising

### 2.1 Leaving Certificate Results 2023

**NOTED:** Document "Academic Council Note on the timing of Leaving Certificate results 2023 and developing a contingency plan for a late issue" was circulated to all members prior to this meeting. Dr. O'Byrne advised members that the SEC have not yet given a date for the release of the Leaving Certificate results and this in turn may impact the start date for incoming first year students. It was acknowledged that the first year experience has been less than ideal the past few years and a contingency plan needs to be put in place should the release of results be delayed again this year.

**AGREED:** Working Group to be established to look at this issue in a holistic manner to include the on-campus experience. D. O'Byrne to e-mail all members seeking volunteers to act

on this Working Group. Given the nature of this Working Group it may be necessary to co-opt non-academic council members to the group.

### 3. Policies for Approval -Interim Academic Regulations

**NOTED:** The following documents were circulated to all members prior to this meeting:

- SETU Academic Regulations for Taught Programmes Revised Discussion Draft (V2) for Academic Council.
- Issues Paper for Academic Council: Areas for Future Consideration by Council and Interim Regulations for Taught Programmes.

**NOTED:** Dr. D. O'Byrne advised members that the regulations being presented today are interim in nature and intended to be in place for one year. These interim regulations will allow us to have a consistent delivery framework across all campuses where no student is disadvantaged while allowing time for Council to debate more "weighty" issues.

**NOTED:** Dr. Chris O'Riordan joined the meeting and gave a brief presentation advising members that:

- All feedback and comments received from Council members since the previous meeting have been considered.
- The issues paper circulated summarises some of the key issues resolved in the new draft
- For 2023/24 regulations, the focus is on alignment and having a unified set of regulations that work across all campuses
- We have adopted the most student-centred approach where differences were identified

Some of the issues to be addressed beyond the 2023/24 regulations include:

- the development of a core academic delivery mode across the university that is unified and consistent
- the usage of the credit accumulation system by the University; discussions around areas such as semesters and stages, modules and programmes, progression, transfer and awards
- the implications of micro-credentials and how these are addressed in regulations and policies
- integration of unified policies that are consistent with the regulatory framework and new delivery model

**NOTED:** It is suggested that a Working group be established to propose a new academic framework. Committees of Academic Council to be involved in developing the terms of reference for this working group. To allow for the new regulations to be in place for 2024/25 academic year the following timeline is suggested:

- Establish terms of reference June 2023
- Establish working group September 2023
- Interim report by working group November 2023
- Final report by working group February 2024
- Implementation plan April 2024

**AGREED**: The Interim Academic Regulations were approved by Council subject to the following minor amendments being made:

- 7.4.2 to include External Examiner feedback
- Professional Masters to be referenced in the document (wording to be provided by Dr. C. Moloney)

**AGREED:** Academic regulations beyond 2023/24 to be included as an agenda item for the next number of meetings of Council

### 4.1 Research Committee

### **4.2 Student Experience Committee**

**AGREED:** The Minutes of the Student Experience Committee meeting of the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2023 were noted by Council.

**NOTED:** D.Denieffe advised members that the two main bodies of work currently being undertaken by the Committee are as follows:

- Fitness to Continue in Study Draft Policy
- Reasonable accommodations

**AGREED:** High level data from the Student Survey 2023 to be presented to the June meeting of Academic Council.

### 4.3 Academic Development, Learning & Teaching Committee

**AGREED:** The Minutes of the Academic Development, Learning and Teaching Committee meeting of the 28<sup>th</sup> March 2023 were noted by Council.

**NOTED:** The Annual Quality Report is due to be submitted to the QQI in May and work is ongoing on this.

**NOTED:** A Working Group on Artificial Intelligence has been established and met on the 24th April, the main areas of concern for this group are regulation, guidance to staff and students and training on best practice, an update on these will be brought to the next meeting of Council.

### 4.3 Academic Quality and Regulation

**AGREED**: The Minutes of the Academic Quality and Regulation Committee meeting of the 31<sup>st</sup> March were circulated to all members prior to this meeting. The following were approved by Academic Council:

**AGREED:** External Examiner nominations from both the Carlow and Waterford campuses were noted and approved by Academic Council.

**AGREED:** Postgraduate matters including Transfer to L10 Register, Admission to L10 Register Examiner nominations for research postgraduate candidates submitting for award and External Reviewer nominations for research postgraduate candidates seeking Confirmation of Doctoral Candidature were noted and approved by Academic Council.

**LanguageCert** - a new type of English language proficiency exam accepted by most universities as well as the Department of Justice for visa purposes was approved as an accepted English language proficient examination for SETU entry.

**NOTED:** Members noted the External Examiners being approved today are quite local and suggested there is a need for some International Externs to give an international perspective on what we do. The role of the External Examiner was discussed and members agreed there is a large body of work to be done in terms of operational matters and payment structures and that the process needs to be redesigned if we want to attract good people.

AGREED: Profile of External Examiners to be brought to future meeting of Academic Council.
