INTRODUCTION

The following is a review report to Academic Council from the panel of assessors on the proposal from the School of Health Sciences at South East Technological University to change certain aspects of the Postgraduate Diploma [in Arts] in Advanced Facilitation Skills for Health and Well Being through the University's Course Evaluation Stage 3 (CE3) process. In accordance with the regulations governing the evaluation of new programme proposals, as set out in the South East Technological University Waterford *Programme Quality Assurance Enhancement Policy and Procedures*, the programme proposal was reviewed by a panel of assessors.
