Student Support Schemes: Subsidy

The LDC is proud to be able to support its students on their educational journey. A Subsidy Scheme with reduced fees is available to the following qualifying persons:

- 1. People in receipt of **DSP payments** need to provide evidence of eligibility including a recent payment receipt (within the last month) and/or a letter from the DSP verifying receipt of payment
- 2. A **Literacy Practitioner Subsidy** is available to those working within Adult Literacy Service & need to be delivering a minimum number of teaching hours per week (hpw) as follows:

L6 programme: 2hpwL7 programme: 4hpwL8 programme: 8hpw

To receive the subsidy, students must submit a form signed by their manager (AEO/ALO), confirming their eligibility, no earlier than 4 weeks before the programme starts. Applications will be accepted after this period.
