

The first university for the South East of Ireland is here, South East Technological University (SETU). We've combined culture and expertise and created something bigger, more ambitious and more transformative.





The inaugural president designate of SETU is Prof Veronica Campbell, a professor of neuropharmacology. She is a TCD fellow, former Dean of Graduate Studies and served as the College's bursar and Director of Innovation from 2015 until 2021. Prof Campbell has a proven track record of strategic project delivery during her time at Trinity.
