



Educational Leadership and Personal Development (10 Credits, Level 9)

Aim of Module	This module will examine the Leadership role in a personal capacity. It will focus upon the importance of motivation, the ability to negotiate and successfully resolve conflict, essential for the progression of the educational establishment. It will provide students with a clear and concise insight into the different styles of educational leadership, the associated theory and the implications for the design and the future development of new progressive learning environments for education in Ireland today. Students will gain insight into the importance of the creation of effective teams and collaborative practice to ensure organisational success. A key component will be student engagement in critical discussion and understanding of the importance of reflective practice, being central to organisational improvement and effective leadership. This module will enable students to understand the importance of a clearly communicated, widely understood, and collectively shared vision and mission for the entire organisation.
