Course overview

This part-time Level 6 award is aimed at current adult and further education tutors/practitioners and those wishing to pursue a career in adult or further education, including adult basic education, Further Education & Training (FET) and community education.



Subject area

The programme aims to equip students with the skills and competencies required to act as tutors, facilitators and trainers in FET settings.

The programme explores theories and good practice in adult basic education and adult education. Participants can apply their learning directly to their practice and share experiences with peers in a supportive learning environment.

- Provide current and future tutors/practitioners with the requisite skill set required for their roles.
- Offer participants a theoretical framework to underpin and enhance their professional practice.



Unique features

This is a part-time blended learning programme with a delivery model that facilitates the working practitioner scheduled on weekend teaching blocks. Delivery will be a mix of on campus and online modes.

Classes are delivered in workshop-style, where collective, collaborative and creative learning is strongly encouraged.

Learning can be applied directly to your practice.

A lecturing team that is hugely experienced in FET & adult literacy. Lecturers value the wealth of experience & knowledge that adult learners bring to the classroom.

Ideally applicants should be actively involved in/tutoring in the Adult & Further Education & Training sector.

Applicants may be invited to attend an interview for entry to the programme.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL): applicants with significant prior experience in FET sector may apply for advanced entry or exemptions using SETU RPL Policy. For further information contact the Programme Leader.
