

Internationalisation in Higher Education

(10 Credits, Level 9)

Module Aim	This module establishes an understanding and awareness of the main issues related to the internationalisation of higher education (HE) in theory and practice. A key aim is to enable students to critically analyse the interrelationship between internationalisation and globalisation. Students will be encouraged to critically reflect on past developments and the changing landscape in HE globally, draw on their own experience, and consider how their professional practice could be enhanced through a greater understanding of ongoing and evolving developments in the area.
Module Learning Outcomes	 Upon successful completion of this module, a student will be able to: Demonstrate an awareness of the issues relating to a range of concepts defining internationalisation in higher education. Articulate the interrelationship between internationalisation and globalisation and their impact on developments in higher education. Evaluate critically the models and frameworks related to internationalisation and the changing role of internationalisation for education and society. Skilfully negotiate the strategies, practices, and challenges to promote a more inclusive approach to internationalisation. Reflect on issues arising from research in this area and apply to your professional context.
